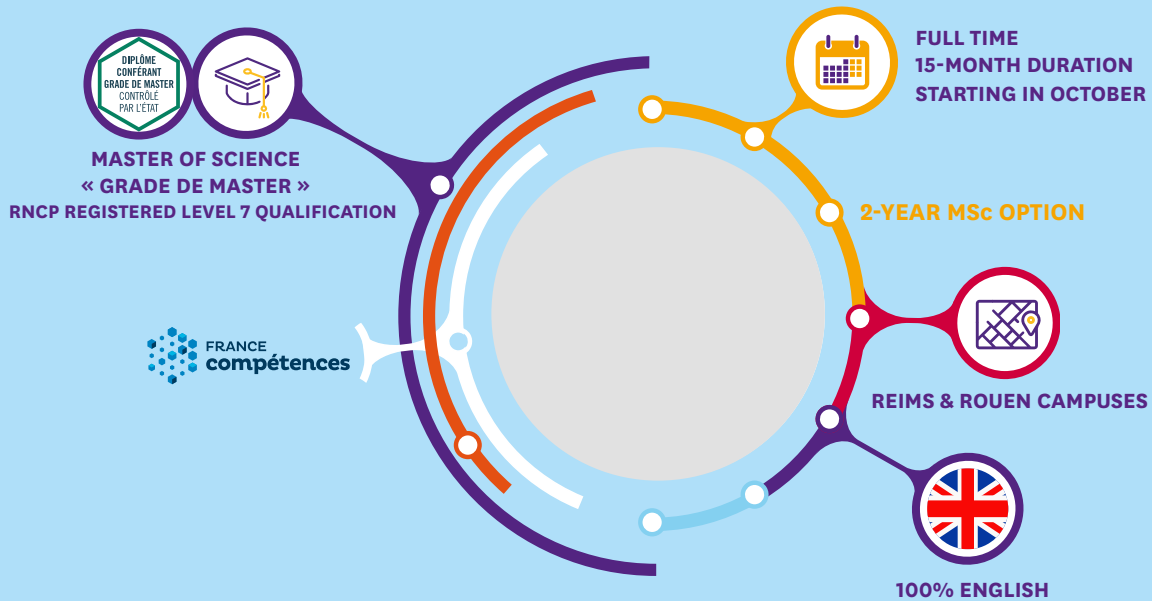

EXPERIENTIAL AND IMMERSIVE APPROACH

Theoretical concepts are applied in case studies and interactive discussions. This hands-on approach allows students to gain a practical understanding of these concepts. Besides, visiting expert speakers are involved in the classroom to share their insights and ideas.

PROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCE (4 TO 6 MONTHS)



An essential opportunity to apply the theoretical and practical skills learnt during the first two semesters in a professional environment. Students are free to carry out the internship in France or abroad, subject to approval by the internship director, based on its relevance to the MSc programme and course content.

TAKING YOUR CAREER TO A NEW LEVEL



It prepares them for careers in the areas of investment banking (M&A and Private Equity), corporate banking, financial advisory / analysis and firms' financial departments (CFO).

- ▶ Equity research analysts (sell side and buy side in financial institutions)
- ▶ Credit analysts
- ▶ Financing/ Leasing managers
- ▶ Cash managers
- ▶ Officers of specialised business finance large businesses (corporate banking in "coverage" or structured finance), etc.
